



Gender Workshop-ILO Convention 190

‘Ending Violence and Harassment in the World of Work’

Wednesday 20 April 2022



ILO Convention No. 190 is the first international convention to recognize the right of everyone to a world of work free from violence and harassment, including gender-based violence and harassment.

On Wednesday 20 April 2022, MACOSS in collaboration with the National Trade Union Confederation (NTUC) and its members organized a one-day workshop on gender -based violence with particular emphasis on the ILO Convention No.190.

The participants had an overview on:

- I. Implementation of Section 114 Workers Rights Act 2019 to End Gender-Based Violence (against Women) in the World of Work
- II. Implementation of ILO C190 to achieving decent work in view of eliminating GBV in the World of Work
- III. National Impact of Convention 190 & State Responsibility.

The key speakers of the day were, Mr Suraj Ray, the Chairperson of MACOSS, Mrs Jane Ragoo, the Vice-president of NTUC, and , Mr. Narendranath Gopee, the President of NTUC.
